- The hotel rooms will be booked by INAPS under the individual names. We have reserved 24 rooms at Coque.
- Breakfast comes with the room.
- You will be responsible for your personal extras and the airport transfers.
- Rooms rates: Single rooms: 60 Euro/Night, Double room: 65 Euro/Night/Room.
- **You are responsible for your accommodation, please pay the hotel directly.**



## How to get to Coque?

- **From the airport:** take the bus 16 in the direction of Bertrange, Ecole Européenne II and get off at **Kirchberg, Antoine de St. Exupéry**. From there it is a 500 meter walk to the hotel.
- **From the train station:** Take the tram in front of the train station in the direction Kirchberg, Luxexpo. Get off at **Kirchberg, Coque**. From there it is a 500 meter walk to the hotel. You can find details of the itinerary on [www.mobiliteit.lu](http://www.mobiliteit.lu).
- **In Luxembourg, public transport is for free.**
- **Taxi:** cabs can be booked in advance via the [web](#). The exact cost of the journey will be communicated to you in advance and payment is possible via the web.

## HOW TO GET THERE?

**From the hotel:** take the tram in the direction of Bonnevoie, Lycée Bouneweg. Get off at **Hamilius** and take either bus 14 in direction of Cents Waassertuerm or bus 15 in direction Hamm Ierzkaulen. Get off at **Cents, Fort Dumoulin**. From there it is a 200 meter walk to INAPS.

We will welcome you on Monday morning at the hotel and accompany you to the venue.
